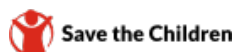

Project Overview:

Capacity building of health workers and health systems at community, primary health care and hospital level, for recognition and management of diabetes and other common non-communicable diseases

Reach Achieved

- >126k people made aware
- 19,073 patients linked to care (Diabetes/CV)
- 105 trained CHWs
- 41 trained Nurses
- 40 trained GPs

Outcomes Achieved

Communities are more aware of NCD risks, prevention and have access to "early" diagnosis

- >20k school-age children engaged in NCD information and discussion sessions
- 7263 households visited by CHWs
- >43k patients using NCD corners

NCD Services and support are easily accessible to patients

- 21 health facilities with improved capability to provide NCD care, including available NCD corners

Patients have improved knowledge and confidence to self-manage their condition

- 7217 patients provided with patient-held record
- >95% patients agreed they are more confident to self-manage

HCPs have improved knowledge, confidence and tools to support Patients

- 100% of Primary Health Care workers showed improved competency of diabetes and NCD management
- 83% reported increased confidence to support patients after the training
