Project Overview:

Implementing a FHADIMAC branch in the South region of Haiti

Reach Achieved

- 20,951 patients made aware/educated (Diabetes/CV)
- 10,184 People screened
- 3413 patients diagnosed (CV)
- 622 patients diagnosed (Diabetes)
- 590 patients linked to care
- 168 trained HCPs (CHWs, nurses, GPs)

Outcomes Achieved:

Communities are more aware of NCD risks, prevention and have access to “early” diagnosis

- Most of patients who attended education sessions (62%-80%) considered they are more aware of NCD risks, more confident to advise a community member or more able to access information on NCDs

NCD Services and support are easily accessible to patients

- Most of patients are satisfied with the services provided at Jeremie (between 60% & 100%)

Patients have improved knowledge and confidence to self - manage their condition

- 600 patients used the NCD care services in Jeremie and >80% of patients adhere to follow-up schedule (consultation appointment)

HCPs have improved knowledge, confidence and tools to support Patient

- 296 sessions (F2F or remote) between HCP in Jeremie and Port-au-Prince HQ, hence improved collaboration with other health facilities that refer patients to Jeremie.
- In addition, 95 paramedics & 120 MDs had access to the UNFM e-learning platform with training modules on Diabetes
