Project Overview:

Integration of NCD services (Hypertension and Diabetes) into TB/ Malaria Services

Reach Achieved

- 40 Supply Chain partners engaged into upgraded transformation
- 3045 people screened
- 139 trained CHWs
- 54 trained Pharmacists
- 175 trained Nurses/Clinical associates/Midwives
- 153 trained GPs

Outcomes Achieved:

Communities are more aware of NCD risks, prevention and have access to “early” diagnosis

- 330k people reached through radio broadcasts in local markets

NCD Services and support are easily accessible to patients

- 9 Health Zones visited, which allowed for the mapping of 2053 pharmacies to be possibly upgraded later.

HCPs have improved knowledge, confidence and tools to support Patient

- 96 health facilities supervised to ensure post training follow-up visits for the trained HCPs
- Therapeutic Guidelines of the 2 National Programs (Diabetes & HBP) were updated as well as the 2 Strategic National Plans
